


\$92 Million Added to Dacula's Tax Rolls

Despite the ongoing recessionary atmosphere of 2007-2013, the City of Dacula continues to experience growth. Since 2003, the City has issued 506 building permits for new commercial and residential structures, adding nearly \$92 million to the tax rolls.

Mayor Wilbanks said, "The City has added nearly \$92 million to the tax rolls through April 2015; by the end of the year we should be above \$100 million in construction costs."
