


DACULA'S PEACE POLE REDEDICATED

After being taken down as a part of the removal of our gazebo from railroad property, Dacula's Peace Pole was rededicated on December 13, 2014.

Originally the Peace Pole was dedicated September 11, 2002, the second anniversary of the 9/11 tragedy.

The Peace Pole Project has some 200,000 peace poles in 195 different countries. Dacula's is right here in Olde Mill Park at the corner of Wilson Street/Second Avenue in Historic Downtown Dacula.
